We have compiled the following "how to ahoi" for you, so that you do not lose the overview.





Change the language to English.





You log in with your user ID, e.g. hxx123, and your self-selected password.



REGISTRATION PERIODS

On the ahoi homepage you will find the dates of the current registration periods for modules and courses.



REGISTRATION PERIODS

You will find the dates of the current registration periods for modules and courses on the start page of ahoi. Please note that you must be registered for the corresponding modules, course and examination in ahoi if you want to take an examination and receive credit points. Please remember that Moodle is your learning platform, but registration in Moodle only is not sufficient (register in ahoi!).


General Registration Period	Registration phase for all students. There is no first-come-first-served principle here, so don't panic if the ahoi server is down in the meantime. Nevertheless, don't wait until the last second to register.
First semester Registration Period	Registration period for first-year students. Only in the winter semester. Here, too, there is no first-come, first-served principle.
Registration Change Period	For changes to your course selection. This phase is scheduled for the first week of lecture period. This way, you can still decide to withdraw after the first date of a course. First come, first served! If you want to get hold of the last places, you have to be quick.


One of the most important ahoi functions is the selection of modules and courses. Before we get to that, a short introduction to the framework conditions of your degree programme:




After you have gained an overview of which courses you would like to choose with the help of the module plan and the course catalogue, you can get started.




When you have found the course you want to take, first register the **module** (for exchange students all modules start with "ID-...")










In next step you register the course (within the module you have just chosen).









In principle, you can take all courses you want if you meet the admission requirements.

There are only a few exceptions (REAP projects / Orientation modules Architecture are not open for exchange students)


- All courses that are scheduled in a semester (e.g. 1. Semester Bachelor Architecture) according
 to the module plan are also scheduled so that they do not overlap in time.
- If you would like to take courses earlier or later from different semesters / programs, please make sure that you do not have any overlapping courses!
- Even with electives or [Q]STUDIES you must make sure that no other courses you take are scheduled at the same time.

What to do if you did not get a place in a course during the general registration period?

 Check whether places have become available during the Registration Change Period (especially after the first date of the course), and if so, register for the course as usual.





Here you will find information on individual courses. Further down the page you will find dates, rooms, materials and module affiliation.





Under the tab Examinations you will find all examinations and dates for which you are registered, this also includes re-examinations.




EXAMINATION REGISTRATION AND DEREGISTRATION
